Programme Description

This program is designed to combine a Chinese language course with on-the-job exposure for professional practices; develop and enhance your Chinese skills in a working environment. First, you attend a language course, then followed by an internship. It is also a great way to learn about the different company culture in China.

We can arrange an internship for you (unpaid) for 4 to 12 weeks. Starting AFTER you finished your Chinese course. Working hours usually full day. We place internship in the professional field you indicate.

Requirements

- o knowledge of Chinese on Elementary Level by the time you start the internship
- o participation in a Chinese language course of min. 4 weeks - longer if you need more time to get to the level
- o minimum age 18
- o finished secondary education
- o time budget of min. 8 weeks (course + internship)

Certificates

You will receive 2 certificates, one from our partners school and one from the host company, upon request. Our partner school certifies your language skills; the host company issues a statement commenting your performance as a trainee.

- CV in English
- Letter of intent in English - describing your language skills, previous professional experiences and expectations regarding the internship

Visa Information

DO NOT apply for a "STUDENT VISA": the student will fail to get the visa! This visa is for long duration at a university in China.

DO NOT apply for a "F" Visa as they are very difficult to extend!

You should **apply only for L Visa (tourist visa)** by your flight tickets before you enter in China. This visa is normally valid for 30 to 90 days. Mandarin House will help you to find a qualified visa agent in China to extend your visa if necessary.

The student should be applying for a tourist visa for the duration of their stay in China.....30, 60 or 90 days. This type of visa can be extended more easily. We will connect the student to a good visa agency, to help them once they arrive in China.

The student should contact the Chinese embassy or a visa agency in your country to obtain the most recent information.
