## Internship & Work Programmes in UK

### About UK minimum wage

From 1st October 2007 it is:

- £5.52 per hour for 22 years old and over
- £4.60 per hour for 18 to 21 years old

Working hours are generally between 35-40 hours per week. Employers reserve the right to increase or decrease weekly hours according to business needs. Some employers and industries may pay more than minimum wage for example Catering and Food/Fish Industries.



### Accommodation

- Professional Internships (non salaried): applicants can be hosted by a selected family once the work placement company has been confirmed.
- Salaried Placements: applicants can ask for a temporary accommodation (no homestay) for the first 5 days on arrival.

### Optional Services

- Account opening Service – fast track bank account opening for candidates in salaried placement.
- Tax Refunds – our partner consultants can help candidates to reclaim overpaid tax after employment finishes.
