ENGLISH INTERNSHIP

Programme Description

No-visa holders

A quick way to learn English is by spending time with native people in an English-speaking country. While the school will provide you with the structure, vocabulary and communication skills that you need, there's nothing like real-life practice to help you use what you learned!

While attending 6 weeks of English classes, you must strive to get your English to the best possible standard. As part of your language development, your teachers may help you write a CV / résumé and polish your conversational skills.

Structure: 6 weeks English Course + 4 – 6 weeks English Practicum

Requirements

- **Minimum age:** 18
- **Minimum level of English:** high-intermediate
- **Start dates:** September to May
- **English course duration:** 6 weeks
- **Type of course:** Exam Preparation Course: IELTS, TOEFL, TOEIC. 20 lessons per week
- **Internship duration:** 4 – 6 weeks

Programme Structure

After you have satisfactorily completed your course and provided you comply with all US immigration laws and visa requirements, TLA may help you find companies, social groups or organizations that will accept you as an observer for 4 to 6 weeks. This extra curricular activity will complement your English-language training. If you request this service, TLA will charge a non-reimbursable fee of \$700 as an administrative reimbursement for the time and expenses sustained while seeking for an Organization or company that will accept you **as an observer**.

Once you are accepted in a company or Organization where you'll have the opportunity to meet native-speakers, you may be asked to help perform tasks or observe another worker. While interacting with other native-speakers, your knowledge and understanding of the US working world along with your conversational skills will improve significantly. At the end of the language practicum period, you will receive a report on your language performance.

Important notes

Companies that accept language students as observers do so on a voluntary basis and exclusively to give the student the opportunity to speak English outside of the classroom. They will not compensate you for the time you spend with them. The amount of time you spend with the company or organization is at your sole discretion. The duration of your language practicum may not exceed the duration of stay in the US allowed by your visa. You may not accept any form of compensation for the time you spend outside of the classroom in a company, organization or social group. Some of the organizations that accept language students operate in the fields of finance, media, the arts, IT, education, travel and tourism, law, and community services. The industry, social context or business field may not relate to

your studies or professional background: it is understood that the time you spend in these organizations is exclusively for your personal enrichment and does not constitute professional training, employment or promise of employment, present or future.

Neither the school nor the company, organization or social group may be held responsible for damages or injuries sustained by you during the time you spend on their premises, except for what established by statutes. In order to be accepted into this program, you must provide proof of medical insurance/coverage in the US.
